

Windows 7 and Vista users of CNMP Software

Special Instructions for Installing Software

If you are using Vista or Windows 7, you will probably need to make a change on your computer's User Account settings before you can install the CNMP Generator software. Otherwise, you will get an error message that looks like this:

Component*comdlg32.ocx or one of its dependencies not correctly registered: a file is missing or invalid.

If you have already installed the software and are getting this error message, **you will need to uninstall it, make the change, and reinstall it.**

Here is the procedure to make the needed change:

Windows 7

1. Click on the Circular **Windows Start** button on the lower left of your screen.
2. Type in **User Accounts** in the search block
3. Choose **Change User Accounts Control Settings**
4. Move setting to **Never Notify**. You will have to restart the computer for the change to take effect.
5. You can now download and install the CNMP Generator software.
6. You can then turn the **User Account Control Settings** back on using the same process.

VISTA

1. In the **Control Panel (Start -> Control panel)**, click **User Accounts**
2. Choose the option to turn **User Account Control** on or off
3. When prompted, turn **UAC** off
4. You can now install the CNMP Generator software
5. At this point you can turn UAC back on

Your CNMP software should now be operational.
